"Believers are responsible for helping each other be faithful disciples. "

How I Treat a Brother or Sister TODAYS'S SCRIPTURE: Luke 17: 1-6

Jesus contends that believers must never do anything which would lead another believer to sin. The phrase "stumbling blocks" is the Greek word skandalon, the noun form of the verb which Paul uses 1 Corinthians 8 when he discusses eating food sacrificed to idols that might lead some to violate their consciences. Someone sins if he encourages others to sin, even if action is not sinful by itself. Jesus said that it would be better to be thrown into sea with millstone tied around neck. The millstone He has in mind is a large, heavy stone used to grind grain nor-

mally be pulled by an ox or a donkey. The little ones that one might cause to stumble probably refers to any believer. Jesus had already referred to believers as "infants" in 10:21.

Believers are responsible for helping each other be faithful disciples. Jesus calls disciples to do more than refrain from causing others to sin. They must also keep others from sinning. "If he repents, forgive him." Jesus does not give the believer the option of refusing to forgive one who asks to be forgiven. He goes on to say that even if a believer sins against another 7 times in a day, the offended one must forgive every time the offender asks.[The number seven is roughly equivalent to "over and over" in this context and should not be taken literally.]

The apostles said to the Lord, "Increase our faith!" Perhaps realizing how much faith one would need to do what Jesus calling them to do, the disciples ask Jesus to increase their faith. "If you have faith like a mustard seed," probably implies that they do have faith. Jesus' parabolic statement is meant to encourage the disciples. [The Greek is somewhat ambiguous, but the exemplary faith of the apostles in the book of Acts most likely suggests that Jesus' intent is to encourage.] They may well have been thinking that following Jesus and being the kind of disciple he was calling them to be was almost impossible.

A mustard seed was proverbially small thing, the smallest seed planted in a garden in Jesus' day. The problem is not "believers" who have too little faith but those who have no faith at all.

Today...I will do my best to help my brothers and sisters grow in faith. *Michael Moss*


