The Churches of Christ Disaster Relief Effort unofficially began operations in 1990. Since then, the organization has distributed more than \$168 million in emergency food and supplies in response to over 535 disasters in 47 states, Puerto Rico, and the US Virgin Islands.

CCDRE stands prepared with a warehouse of supplies ready to have on the road within hours of a disaster. Donations allow them to purchase needed supplies in large volume, at extreme discounts, whenever they need them. They are able to stretch our donation dollar to buy 3-4 times what you could purchase at retail prices. They don't have to wait for donated goods to come in before they can send supplies out.

EEM publishes, prints, and distributes Bibles and Bible-based materials in 30+ countries and 20+ languages through a vast network of partner churches and organizations.

The mission of EEM began in 1961 when a small band of missionaries bravely answered God's call to take his Word to people under the rule of the Soviet Union. Smuggling Bibles and underground printing were the only ways to share God's Word until the wall fell in 1989. Today, they freely supply Bibles and Biblebased materials.

These materials are given to individuals, families, children in youth camps, refugees, mission churches, public universities, public schools, public libraries, prisons, hospitals, orphanages, campaign groups, and anywhere else Bibles are needed.
